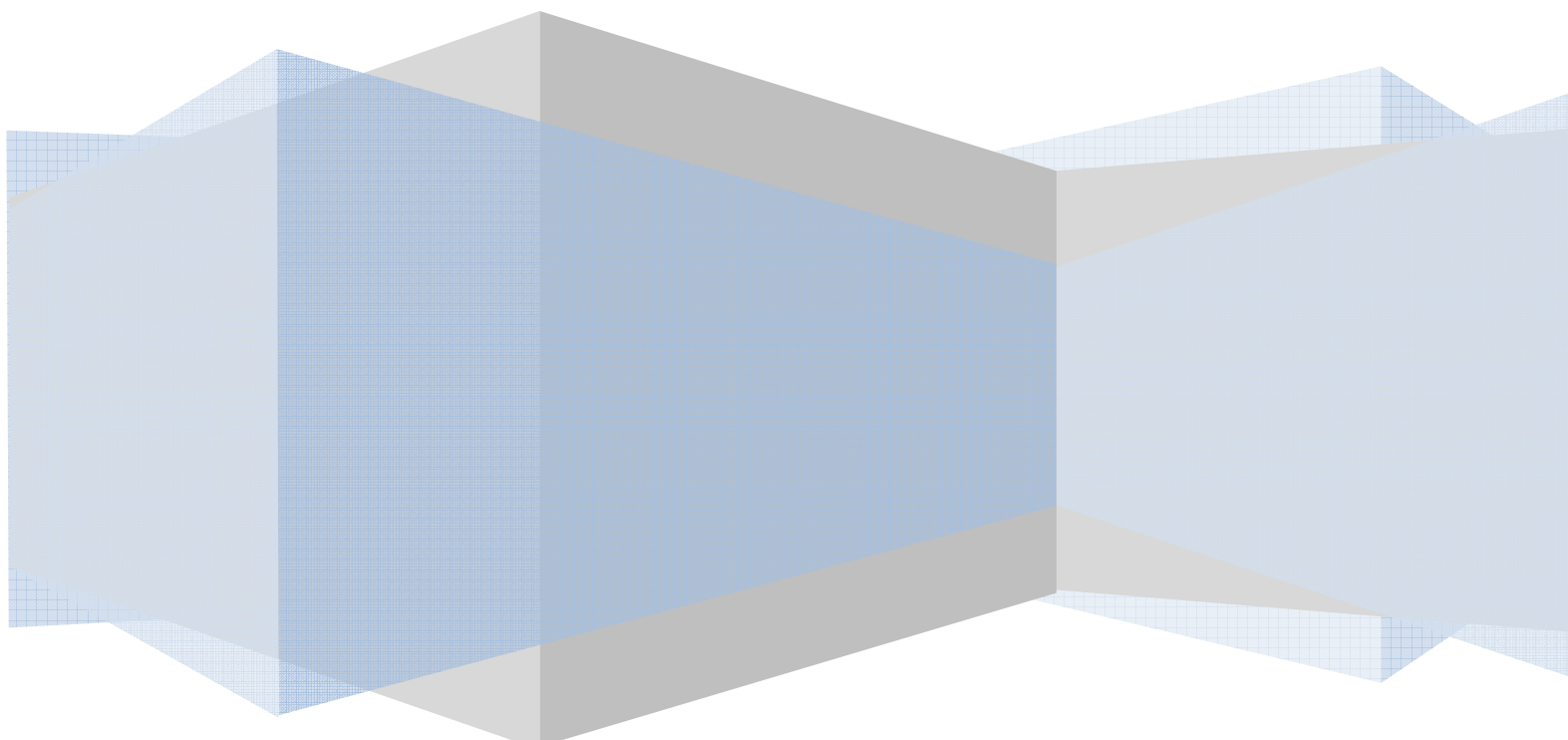
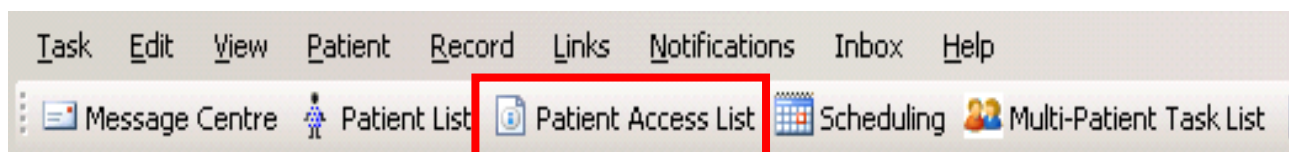


Medication Administration and Using the Medication Chart View

Pharmacology
 Dalteparin is a low molecular weight heparin, produced by nitrous acid depolymerisation of porcine heparin. Dalteparin has a molecular weight which ranges from 2,000 to 9,000 and averages 5,000 daltons, compared to heparin which ranges from 2,000 to 30,000 and averages 13,500 daltons. Dalteparin cannot be used interchangeably with unfractionated heparin or other low molecular weight heparins on a unit for unit basis.
 The anticoagulant effect of dalteparin is primarily due to decreased factor Xa and thrombin activity. Due to its smaller molecular size, dalteparin has a four-fold greater anti-Xa activity than unfractionated heparin. Dalteparin has little effect on activated partial thromboplastin time. Higher doses of low molecular heparins have been associated with sustained and prolonged plasma antithrombin activity.
Pharmacokinetics
 The following data refer to anti-factor Xa activity of dalteparin.
 The bioavailability of dalteparin following subcutaneous injection ranges from 81% to 93%. The bioavailability of dalteparin greatly exceeds that of unfractionated heparin.
 The plasma protein binding of dalteparin is less than unfractionated heparin in patients with normal renal and hepatic function.
 The volume of distribution (Varea/F) ranges from 0.04 to 0.06 L/kg following intravenous injection in patients with normal renal and hepatic function.
 The plasma clearance (CL/F) ranges from 0.14 to 0.41 mL/min/kg following intravenous injection in patients with normal renal and hepatic function.
 The elimination half-life ranges from 1.7 to 2.8 hours following intravenous injection and from 3 to 5 hours following subcutaneous injection in patients with normal renal and hepatic function. Longer half-lives after subcutaneous dosing are apparently due to delayed absorption.

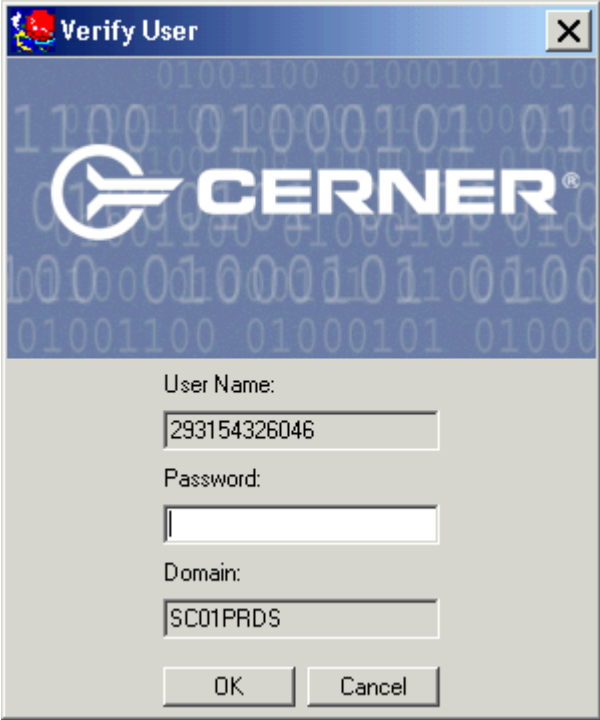

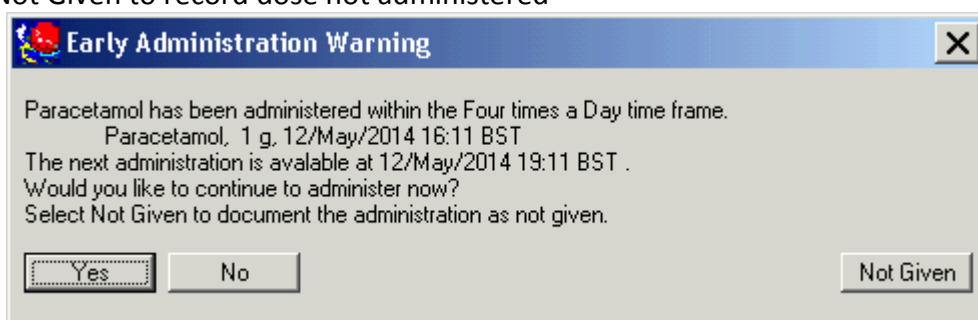
